A five (5) year plan of action – At a glance

- Increase collaboration between gifted and talented learners and members of the community, business and industry.
- Create a low cost identification toolkit for parents and care-takers of gifted and talented children while growing our own **Be Remarkable Projects**.
- Support gifted and talented education networks within and between early childhood settings and schools with more extended learning opportunities online.
- Help build the capacity of careers practitioners and teachers to engage gifted and talented young people.
- Work with universities to encourage opportunities for pre-service learning in gifted and talented education and encourage postgraduate study in gifted education.
- Provide support for early childhood settings and schools to evaluate their programs.

Funding Initiatives

Support campaigns and advocate for successful models for identification, curriculum and rewarding gifted and talented students.

Provide funding support for:

- ❖ Leaders in early childhood settings and schools
 - ❖ Organizations that provide professional G&T learning for teachers
 - ❖ Identification toolkit for early childhood professionals and teachers
 - ❖ New guidelines for early entry to school and acceleration
 - ❖ Tools and strategies that support effective identification of gifted and talented children
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- Generate \$12 million for educational and community organizations to develop and deliver high-quality extension programs for gifted and talented students.
 - Generate \$15 million for selected nonprofits that provide outreach and development activities for innovative and inventive students.
